I want to see the Rottneest wildlife

- Take your pick from these options and start your morning with a wildlife experience to remember:
 - See the beauty that lies beneath the water, on the **Subsea Explorer** with an underwater viewing window to shipwrecks, coral and marine creatures.
 - Join the free **Whitecaps and Wilderness** walking tour from Parker Point to discover the Island's flora and fauna. Maybe you'll see the Eastern Osprey.
 - Walk the **Ngank Wen Bidi** trail to Cathedral Rocks to spot New Zealand fur seals. If it's migration season, you may even see humpback whales.
- Break for lunch in the **Main Settlement** and keep a look out for one of the resident peacocks.
- Head to one of the Island's **63 beaches** and discover the treasures in the rocky shores or take the plunge into the clear waters.
- End your day with a **#quokkaselfie!** Some of our favorite spots are **Garden Lake** behind Karma Rottneest, **Parker Point** and **Heritage Common**. **Quokka stop on Digby Drive** and **under the fig tree near Karma Rottneest** are great spots in the afternoon and evening.
